<u>Call for applications: Erasmus Plus scholarships to study at Bielefeld</u> University during the spring semester of 2018

The European Union is offering 4 scholarships for Master's and PhD students* to study at Bielefeld University within the Erasmus Plus Program.

The program is open for MA and PHD students in Sociology or Political Science (same department). However they can combine courses in these subjects with other English taught courses if they meet the prerequisites and places are available.

Requirements	 A. Registered student at TAU B. Minimum average of 80 C. Fluent English/German – the minimum required level is B2 D. Students from the department of Sociology and/or Political Science. Master's students can only participate in the program from the 1st semester of the second year of studies until the 1st semester of the last year of studies. G. PhD students can arrive to Bielefeld for a shorter period than 6 months (the minimum period is 3 months = 90 days). Since PhD students do not have to take courses, they can also arrive to Bielefeld during the summer for example, and not necessarily during the semester dates, as long as their supervisor is present at Bielefeld during their stay. Scholarship details	The grant sum will be issued for the period March 14 – July 31, 2018 approx. 4,180 EUR
Number of required credits for and master's students	Students are recommended to take 30 ECTS credits (equivalent to 15 TAU credits), but Bielefeld does not have a minimum requirement of credits. * Deviations may be possible, pending approval from Bielefeld University * According to TAU regulations, 1 TAU credit is equivalent to 2 ECTS credits.
